At the end of today's lesson you will;

Evaluate claims about the causes of Australia's high skin cancer rate.

Classwork-

• Light Waves 4.1

- Students apply what they have learned in the Light Waves unit as they investigate how light travels through ocean water to understand the vision of crabs.
- Students are told that the crabs eat plankton, but that there are low levels of visible light near the ocean floor.
- They consider the Science Seminar Question: Can the crabs see the plankton they eat near the ocean floor?, then evaluate two claims that attempt to answer it.
- Students individually read and annotate a set of evidence cards, then discuss and sort the evidence with their partners, considering which claim each piece of evidence best supports.
