- **Critical Juncture Thermal Energy 4.4 End of Unit Assessment**
- *Students complete an End-of-Unit Assessment consisting of 16 multiple-choice questions and 2 written-response questions in which they analyze and interpret data, evaluate evidence, and construct explanations.*
- *The End-of-Unit Assessment indicates where students fall along the levels of the Progress Build after instruction by measuring their mastery of the specific ideas—including unit-specific science concepts and crosscutting concepts—that comprise each level of the Progress Build.*
- *The End-of-Unit Assessment also measures students' understanding of important supporting content not explicitly included in the Progress Build.*
- *When analyzed with the Pre-Unit Assessment and Critical Juncture, the End-of-Unit Assessment results indicate students' progress over the course of the unit..*
