At the end of today's lesson you will;

- *What causes climate change?*

Classwork-

- **Earth's Changing Climate 3.3**
- *Students investigate how people might be able to reduce the amount of carbon dioxide and methane in the atmosphere. Students focus on one of the solutions presented in the article "Climate Change Solutions."*
- *They apply their understanding of unit concepts to make sense of the selected solution: what it is, why it is needed, how it works, and whether or not it is a good idea.*
- *Students share what they learned with a partner, before modeling their solution in the Modeling Tool.*
- *These activities serve to prepare students for the homework, which is a written explanation of the solution and its effect on climate.*
- *The purpose of this lesson is to allow students to use what they learned and share their understanding of how people can combat climate change.*
