At the end of today's lesson you will;

- Why do species, both living and extinct, share similarities and also have differences?

Classwork-

- Evolutionary History 1.3
- Students continue to learn about similarities between species. After looking at shared structures in the forelimbs of two species, students read about how body structures reveal a shared common ancestor between whales and humans.
- The teacher models a new Active Reading strategy: summarizing. Students discuss the text by reflecting on their annotations. For homework, students explore the Evolutionary History Simulation.
