Classwork-

- Natural Selection 2.5 - Critical Juncture Check
- Students complete a Critical Juncture Assessment consisting of 12 multiple-choice questions and 2 written-response questions. The Critical Juncture is designed to reveal students' current levels of understanding of the unit's core content, and the results are used to place each student at a particular level on the Progress Build. These assessment results indicate students' progress from the beginning of the unit and are used to group students for differentiated instruction in the next lesson. As with the Pre-Unit Assessment, the Critical Juncture includes content beyond what a student is expected to have mastered.
